## **RE: 2022 TID Policies and Operations Plan**

Please find enclosed three documents to reference for information about how TID plans to manage and operate through the 2022 irrigation season. The 2022 Water Supply and Operations Policy and 2022 TID Well Irrigated Acres Program have been updated with a few key modifications from previous versions you may have seen, and the addition to the packet is the 2022 Water Management Operations Plan.

The 2022 Water Management Operations Plan explains TID's strategic plan for diversion of the small surface water allotment that has been made available from Upper Klamath Lake. This includes details of how TID will operate and attempt to make a portion of the surface water available for Lease Lands irrigation.
