1. CONSIDER: Draft Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) Annual Report for Water Year 2022.

Kyle Knutson from MBK Engineering provided a background on the draft Annual Report for Water Year 2022. Knutson reported the water year covered is from October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022. Knutson reported the outline is consistent with the outline provided by DWR for the content of an Annual Report. Knutson reported information was gathered from Tulelake Irrigation District and DWR as the main groundwater and water quality data sources used within the report. Knutson reported on the updated Project and Management Acts (PMAs). Knutson reported a grant application was submitted to assist with filling the data gaps in the subbasin. Knutson reported the award for the grant would be announced in the spring or summer of 2023.

Committee Member Wright inquired if the individual charts were individual monitoring wells.

Knutson reported on the groundwater wells used and stated the dark blue line represented the actual reported measurements at the wells. Knutson reported the two horizontal dash lines are two items we developed as part of the GSP process. Knutson reported the higher blue dash line is the measurable objective and the lower orange dash line is the minimum threshold. Knutson reported the blue line was based on historical averages and the orange line was based on historical minimums.

Committee Member Wright asked if the wells were both domestic and irrigation wells.

Knutson reported the wells used are both irrigation and domestic wells.

A discussion was held on the identification of the wells used in the report and Knutson reported they could make the graph like the one used in the GSP that identifies the type of well. Knutson clarified that the wells used in the Annual Report are the identified representative monitoring wells.

Committee Member Martinez inquired as to why the contour maps are shrinking each year and expressed concerns that the Modoc County portion of the basin is getting less coverage related to data.

Knutson reported figures 2-1 and 2-2 Committee Martinez is inquiring about are the wells that have been historically monitored and utilized for the development of groundwater level contour maps both in the GSP and TID's groundwater management plans. Knutson reported they prepared two contour maps, one for Spring 2021 and one for Spring 2022, and then compared the difference in average groundwater levels for Spring 2021 and Spring 2022. Knutson reported they then applied the average across the whole subbasin. Knutson reported that even though this area is not covered on the map blue, it is accounted for because they are using the whole area of the subbasin to estimate total groundwater extractions. Knutson reported there are other voluntary wells in the Modoc County area that are not covered by blue and stated the information does get monitored but would be incorporated into the five-year update of the GSP.

Committee Member Martinez provided a handout with the voluntary monitoring wells available in the CASGEM system on the Modoc County side.

A discussion was held on the data for the voluntary wells.

Committee Martinez asked about the DWR water years and inquired as to why there is no normal.

Knutson reported that the water year is categorized as the Sacramento water year and stated there is no average or normal year. Knutson reported for the Sacramento water year there are critical, dry, below-normal, above-normal, and wet years and DWR uses these designations to manage and compare water years. Knutson reported that as part of the GSP development for the Tulelake Subbasin and as a part of the SGMA requirements you must have water year types as a way to compare water year budgets. Knutson reported they didn't want to use the Sacramento water year type because they felt it was not applicable and stated there is not a water year type for the Klamath basin, so through the GSP development they created a water year type for the Tulelake Subbasin which is based on upper Klamath Lake inflow since this seemed to be the primary driver for what type of water year it would be in the Tulelake Subbasin. Knutson reported they developed similar categories for the Tulelake Subbasin water year which are very dry, dry, abovenormal, and wet.

Committee Wright reported that unfortunately, the water year type is not a direct correlation to surface water.

Knutson stated that is a great point and it is a hydrology index but it is the regulation part that is becoming the bigger driver.

Knutson reported the Annual Report is due to DWR by April 1st. Knutson reported the only change to the report he has heard during the discussion is to add the type of well to the hydrographs which was suggested by Committee Member Wright.

2. ACTION: Approve Draft Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) Annual Report for Water Year 2022.

Ordered on a motion by Committee Member Ebinger, seconded by Committee Member Wright to approve as amended the Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) Annual Report for Water Year 2022 with the addition of the type of well added to the hydrographs.

Committee Member Martinez asked if each GSP would be approving the recommended Annual Report. Committee Member Martinez reported the Modoc GSA would be reviewing and potentially approving the recommended Tulelake Subbasin Annual Report.

Committee Member Beasly asked MBK Engineering if the other GSAs needed to approve the recommended Annual Report.

Knutson reported that historically the last Annual Report was only approved by the Core Team.

Committee Member Martinez reported the Modoc GSA reviewed and approved the last Annual Report.

Committee Member Parker reported they also presented the Annual Report to the Siskiyou GSA but would need to review if it was a discussion item or an action item.

Committee Member Martinez reported the Modoc GSA would be reviewing and potentially approving the 2022 Annual Report.

Motion carried unanimously by a roll call vote.

3. DISCUSSION: Siskiyou Well Permitting Process.

Committee Member Parker reported that before the Executive Orders, the GSAs and the Environmental Health Department had started drafting new rules related to the Scott and Shasta Valley for new ag production wells related to the public trust and stemming from litigation against the Siskiyou County in the Scott Valley. Committee Member Parker stated they have now begun to address the Executive Orders related to well permitting.

Committee Member Parker provided an overview of the proposed well-permitting process to address the Executive Orders that have stricter well-permitting rules and detailed the difference between the groundwater basins within Siskiyou County. Committee Member Parker provided a background on the public outreach conducted to obtain input on the proposed well-permitting process.

Committee Member Beasly asked if Siskiyou County would be doing a resolution for each basin or one resolution that would cover all of the basins.

Committee Member Parker reported the resolution would reference the new wellapplication process guideline which would be applied to all basins. Committee Member Parker reported the well-application process guidelines would be a living document that could be updated as needed.

Committee Member Martinez asked if the Butte Valley Subbasin process was similar to the Tulelake Subbasin process and did not have any public trust doctrine issues.

Committee Member Parker reported that is correct but the flow chart needs to be updated to show Butte Valley and Tulelake as separate paths.

Committee Member Martinez asked if there would be a difference in the process between Butte Valley and the Tulalke Subbasin.

Committee Member Parker stated the process would not be different and that they would need to follow the Executive Order language which would mean they would need approval from the GSA. Committee Member Parker reported they are looking for input as to what level of detail or evaluation the county wants to see from the GSAs.

Knutson asked if the following proposed changes were from the Executive Order: 1) The well is not likely to interfere with nearby wells; 2) Not likely to cause subsidence. Knutson asked if this was essential the change, to conduct the analysis to address one and two of the Executive Order.

Committee Member Parker reported that is correct and stated if the Executive Order went away they would not have to conduct this process. Committee Member Parker stated the new Executive Order extends until next February.

Knutson asked about the Pre-Application Checklist which requires a letter from a Geologist and stated he felt it needed to state a Geologist or Hydrogeologist.

Committee Member Parker concurred with the recommendation.

Knutson reported there were some failed attempts at making the Executive Order requirements permanent but agrees with Committee Member Parker that the issue is not going away.

A discussion was held on the approval process of the guidelines and how comments could be submitted.

Committee Member Wright asked about the list of Hydrogeologists and how many would be willing to sign off on the analysis.

Committee Member Parker reported the county is struggling with this portion of the process and provided a background on the potential issues.

Committee Member Wright stated he has reviewed other counties in California and has put it all on the GSAs with no language on the hydro study and stated TID is questioning this process.

A further discussion was held on the proposed guidance documents and the Executive Orders.

Mike McCohen asked if the county is going to ask the well applicant to sign an indemnification waiver and have the applicant take all of the liability, then why is the county even involved in the well permitting process?

Committee Member Parker reported he would have to refer the question to County Counsel but would record the comment to add to the public input.

Elizabeth Nielsen reported on the need to add additional language to the guidance document detailing how the GSA would provide an acknowledgment that the well application is consistent with the GSP.
